Lawrence Land Development Code

The EDC sent a letter of support with recommended changes to the Planning Commission on July 26. The letter is attached to the email you received with this update.

The letter to the Planning Commission indicates:

- 1. Support of the technical requests of the LHBA.
- 2. Request all administrative procedures to have associated time frames.
- 3. Request all administrative timeframes be reviewed and adopted annually by a public body.
- 4. Request all applications be deemed complete or not within 5 business days of receipt.
- 5. Request applications not be held up for minor technicalities
- 6. Request applications be "deemed: approved if staff fails to meet their timeline.

The Planning Commission will be taking public comments on the Land Development Code at each meeting through September when they will vote on the code. Please take time to submit comments or testify in person. We will send updates if anything appears to change from what we know right now.

Lawrence be a healthy well-balanced community. This CIP is a big win for development! Between the 2024 and 2025 CIPs funds are north of \$80 million for new development.

The CIP will be heard again when the City Commission votes on the entire budget on September 3, 10 or 17. We will update everyone on the specific date once the agendas are published.
